

Introduction

Sirhan B. Sirhan legally appointed his brother Adel Sirhan and me to be his researchers in his case. The first thing I did was to hire a criminalist to examine and photograph the evidence but also the evidence envelopes and official records.

When I discovered serious problems ranging from evidence tampering to substitution of evidence I brought in additional experts.

All of my life I have been pro law enforcement – that has not changed. And I was aware of the crime labs often operating under serious budget restraints. I was not looking for a conspiracy, and I tried to remain objective and create a truthful and open report of my findings.

Since I was a housewife without credentials I turned to the lessons I learned from Lorenzo Valla's The Art of Textual Criticism.

My research was the basis of the appeals filed with the court on Sirhan's behalf. Unfortunately, Sirhan's appellate attorney made additions to my work which were both false but damaging. I demanded he file errata with the court and all I got were promises. One example was the Los Angeles County Grand Jury Transcript [6-7-68] in which the alleged Sirhan gun was received into evidence but nowhere in that entire transcript was the serial number of the gun recorded into the record.

Lawrence Teeter [Sirhan's attorney] gratuitously added that the gun manufacturer was also not included. That was untrue. The LACGJ did in fact record the manufacturer's name. My working relationship with Mr. Teeter came to an end.

Lawrence Teeter died last year [four years after my break with him].

Adel Sirhan died in May 2001. As he lay dying of cancer he telephoned me he was writing his last letter and that it would be about his brother Sirhan. It was his dying request. I received it later that week and I open this report with Adel's letter.

To that I would like to add one final thought. Do not be afraid and do not feel intimidated to ask why?

The report presented here represents a portion of my research. When I was invited to donate my research files to the Henry C. Lee Institute of Forensic Science @ the University of New Haven, Conn. I felt honored.

To whom it may concern:

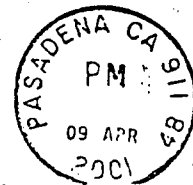
Just as DNA evidence overturns False convictions
