Dear Chief:

By letter dated February 14, 1969, Sheriff Pitchess advised Chief of Police Thomas Reddin that his department stood ready to perform supplementary analysis of certain real evidence obtained in the investigation of the above-entitled case.

At the trial no issue was raised with respect to the examination of the said evidence by criminalists of the Los Angeles Police Department and there appears little likelihood that any questions will be raised in the future.

In the opinion of the District Attorney, independent analysis of the evidence by criminalists of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department is an unnecessary precaution.
